The United States is the only country in the world that permits youth to be sentenced to life without parole. 25 states and D.C. have banned juvenile life without parole (ILWOP). Players Coalition has been advocating for ending JLWOP across remaining states.

#### BREAKING **CLES OF GUN** HE

Players Coalition has invested over \$1.3M in grants to organizations committed to ending gun violence and addressing its root causes. Through meetings with the White House and legislators on Capitol Hill, players continue to advocate for policies and funding to support violence prevention and community violence intervention through a public health approach.
